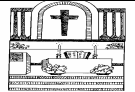

**Child Abuse Month: Audit Compliance** The United States Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) requires all dioceses in the U.S. to undergo yearly audits to verify their compliance with the Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People. Since 2003, the Diocese of Syracuse has been found compliant with all audited articles within the Charter. Passing the audit for the 15<sup>th</sup> year not only reflects the quality of the Safe Environment training programs offered, but more importantly, reflects the commitment and dedication of all clergy, religious, diocesan/parish employees, and volunteers who play a significant role in maintaining safe environments for all children and youth across the diocese (40,000 to date!)
