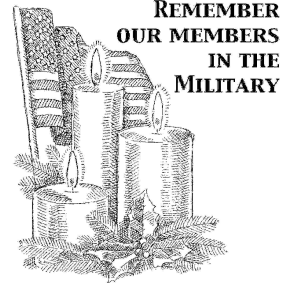
Congratulations to Ellie Auberger, winner of OLPH's 50/50 for January.
